LUNCH ACCOUNTS

All 6th graders will eat during A Lunch and 7th & 8th graders will eat during B or C lunch, depending on the 4th period class. All students will have a PIN number for their lunch account.

Money can be put into a student's account through the cafeteria by check (made out to Klein ISD Food Services) or by cash. Cash payments must be made through the NetCash machine located in the cafeteria. Payments can also be made online at www.pamslunchroom.com. Internet payments will typically take a full business day to reach the account and will take two days to be reflected on the website.

DRESS CODE REMINDERS

As you shop for back-to-school clothes, please keep the school dress code in mind. Complete guidelines are available in the student handbook. General guidelines include:

- Shorts and skirts must be mid-thigh in length
- No excessively baggy pants
- No frayed pants or pants with any frayed holes
- No bare midriffs
- No tank tops, low cut, or see through blouses
- No T-shirts with inappropriate messages
- No leggings or tights worn as pants.

CELL PHONE, ELECTRONIC DEVICE POLICY



This is to remind parents and students that electronic devices are not to be seen or heard during the school day. Cell phones must be kept put away and turned off. If an adult on campus sees or hears a cell phone, it will be confiscated and turned in to the AP office.
