IMPORTANT- Be sure to put "Hildebrandt" as your child's when filling out the Child(ren) Info tab. This is how we will be able to find you and add you to our group. You should receive a confirmation email right away. If you do not, your form did not go through. Approvals take 3-5 business days. Logging Your Volunteer Hours in CERVIS. Logging in your hours is an important part of helping the school. The District takes this information into consideration when giving grants etc. to schools. Here are the steps:

1. Go to <http://www.kleinisd.net/>
2. Click on the "District" on the top menu and under "Departments" click on the **Community Relations** link
3. On the left menu Click on "Volunteers"
4. Scroll down and under Information Links, click on " ☆ CERVIS Login "
5. Make sure you register/ set your password using the link provided in your approval email from Klein. Once that is completed, you can log-in to CERVIS.
6. Click on "Record / Update Service Project Activity"
7. On the next screen, in the **Step 2: Select a Service Project Below** box select "Hildebrandt Volunteers 2019-2020"
8. In the **Service Date** box type in or select the date
9. In the **Service Hours** box type in the number of hours in whole numbers or decimals. For example; 1 ½ hours will be 1.5.
10. The **Notes** field is optional but useful to keep track of what volunteer work has been done.
11. Then click on the **Step 4: Record Service Project Activity** button.
